HISTORIC:

- Wistariahurst Museum – Electrical repair. Request: \$104,500
- City Hall Stained Glass Windows – Restoration. Request: \$80,000
- Lady Liberty in Veterans' Park – Restoration Study. Request: \$25,000
- Holyoke Merry-Go-Round – Restoration of 4 Horses. Request: \$26,170 (\$6,543/horse)
- Holyoke Armory – Restoration (contingent on securing a developer). Request: \$400,000
- Victory Theatre (MIFA) – Restoration of Murals & Theater Seats. Request: \$100,000.
- Armour & Company (130 Race Street) – Historic Façade. Request: \$90,000

OPEN SPACE/ RECREATIONAL LAND

- Jones Point Park (Parks & Rec) – Playground upgrade. Request: \$200,000
- Mayer Field (Parks & Rec) – Playground upgrade. Request: \$210,000; Alternate reduced request: \$155,000 each. Mayer Field is priority.
- Holyoke YMCA – Recreational Space. Request: \$148,274; Alternate reduced request: Phase 1 - \$88,000; Phase 2 - \$55,000 – total \$143,000).
- Housing Authority – Toepfert Basketball Court. Request: \$100,000; Alternate reduced request: \$81,456.40.

- Home Ownership Housing, 800-808 Dwight St. (One Holyoke CDC) – Creation of two new family homes. Request: \$199,101.
- Jackson St. First Time Home Buyer, 484 Chestnut St. (Holyoke Housing Authority & Habitat for Humanity) – Creation of two new single-family homes along Jackson St. Request: \$200,000.
